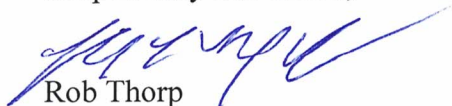

After the system was up and running, it was discovered that there was interference on our frequency. It turns out, the FCC sold all of the frequencies in the 217 range to Eversource. We were supposed to be notified but never were as far as I'm aware. The only fix is to apply for a new frequency which is underway.
