- 1. A residence at 84 Everett Park wants to build an addition consisting of a two-bay garage, two bedrooms and a bath. Adam Ricker called with concerns that the Water Precinct would not allow the addition. I did inform Adam that this is not something that The Precinct would normally get an application for. However, I advised him that I would run it by the Board of Commissioners.
- 2. A business at 209 Main St. would like to convert a detached shop space into two apartment units. My feeling is that the owners should make application to The Water Precinct. I'm looking for the Board's stance on this.
- 3. I received an application for service on a property in Camp Wallula.
- 4. The leak detection survey went well. One unaccounted for leak was detected on Gould Rd. The leak was due to packing on a valve stem. This valve was shut off and we will be working on this tomorrow. Another issue was detected on Barrett Rd. A resident there had a leaking toilet. The resident was aware and had already called a plumber. This water was accounted for.
- 5. We had A&D Instruments reset and change the increments on the master meter at Colby Point. The meter was set up originally in default mode which reads to the nearest 10,000 gallons. It is now set to read every gallon. This will help with the accuracy of our unaccounted-for water.
- 6. We passed our latest round of lead and copper sampling. TTHM and HAA5 also came back within acceptable levels.
- 7. We replaced the hydrant on Homan Lane. Over the winter, it developed a gasket leak. The warranty period has expired. Tony and I will repair this hydrant this winter and place it back in inventory
- 8. Jon and Tony have started easement mowing. They will be starting meter reading a week early this fall. The reason for this is that Maggi has a scheduled vacation and I would like Jon and Tony to take their time so Tony can get a handle on the process.
- 9. Tony is picking things up very quickly. Jon has been doing an outstanding job training him.
- 10. I have been trying to get a schedule from the tank cleaning company. I have advised them that after November, we may not be able to get to the tank with their equipment. They have been back in touch with me and are working on a schedule.
